

DIRECTIONS:

I-81 - Take Exit 164 (Route 29) to Exit 3 (Wilkes-Barre/Nanticoke Exit). Left at Stop Sign at end of ramp (facing Dundee Gardens). Follow approx. 2.3 miles through Main Street in Nanticoke into Sheatown. At top of hill bear to right. Grounds are on Left behind St. Stans Apts. - enter between the Apts. & Guardian Medical Center.

Route 11 to Route 29, over Bridge and Take 1st exit (Nanticoke). Bear Right. Follow approx. 2.1 miles through Main Street in Nanticoke into Sheatown. At top of hill bear to right. Grounds are on Left behind St. Stans Apts. - enter between the Apts. & Guardian Medical Center.

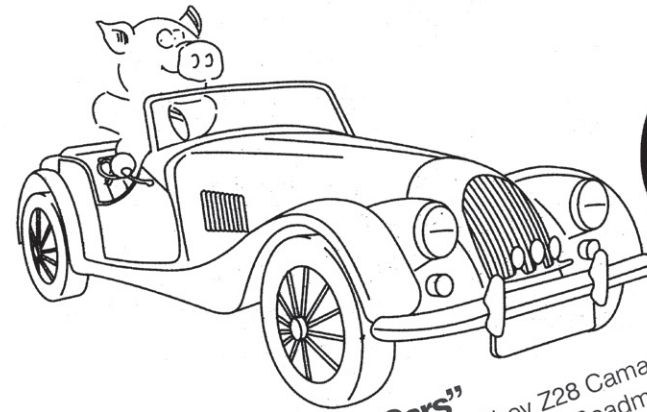

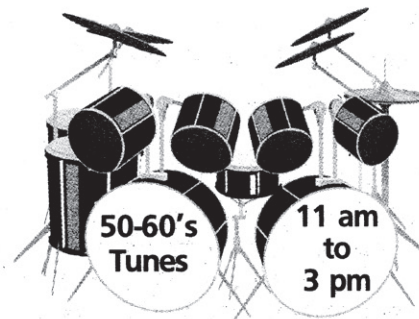
